There were still a few supplies needed for the hospital in Shunga, so I got in touch with a company that produces a small breathing support device for newborns and premature babies.

They were very interested in contributing to the hospital's work and made it possible for us to purchase the device at an incredibly discounted price. What a wonderful gift — and one that will save lives!

- I'm deeply thankful for all the people supporting me and the hospital in Shunga in various ways — especially those donating medical supplies and equipment.
- This season of preparation has brought many small expenses that really add up — and yet, again and again, I've seen God's provision, often through people who see my needs and bless me generously.

Request

I am also very grateful if you would continue to pray and keep me in mind — that this season of preparation continues to go well.

- Right now, the only thing still missing is the visa for Tanzania. It would be such a blessing if that could be processed before my departure!
- Because of the change in plans regarding the car, new donors are needed to help cover the costs and make the purchase possible.
- It's not easy to find a good and suitable vehicle, and I would be very thankful if the purchase could still go through in August.
- The journey to Tanzania is always demanding and full of challenges. Especially once I arrive in the country, unexpected situations can arise at any time. It really takes protection and wisdom to arrive safely and start well.
- I would also be incredibly thankful if more mission partners and regular monthly supporters would join the team. This work — and my departure — is only possible when people invest and walk alongside me!
