Dear Friends,

The new year is already a few weeks old, and I would like to warmly greet you with this year's Bible verse.

And he who was seated on the throne said,
"Behold, I am making all things new."

Revelation 21,5

Many things have already changed and will continue to change this year. I would like to share this journey with you and invite you to be part of it. During the first two months of the year, there were several **staff changes** involving Tanzanian employees. We are accompanying these transitions and introducing the new staff members to their work at the hospital.

A personal **highlight for me in January** was my little kitten Theo. He was found by friends, lonely and alone, and was probably only about six weeks old. I was very happy to take him in, and since then there has been much more life in the house, which I am really enjoying.



At the beginning of February, **triplets were born** at the hospital. Even though this does happen from time to time, it is still something very special—especially because, given the circumstances, caring for them is an even greater challenge than it would be in Germany.

We are grateful that the three children are doing well and are now gaining weight steadily. With the triplets, the family now has nine children to care for and unfortunately very limited resources. All the more wonderful that there were no major complications and that the three will hopefully be able to go home soon.

Again and again, there are **African encounters** that are not without their challenges. One day I was called because there was a snake on the compound—a black mamba, which is venomous and definitely something you want to avoid. Fortunately, our carpenter handled the situation well, and the danger was quickly brought under control.
